Class 1 Best Condition - Highland youngstock - 1,2 & 3 year old Colt, Filly or Gelding

Class 2 Best Condition - Highland - 4 years & over Stallion, Mare or Gelding

Best Condition Championship 1st & 2nd Prizewinners from classes 1 & 2 eligible

NPS/Leyhills Stud M & M in hand Championship

To be run under National Pony Society Rules 2021/2022

Classes 3-5 are qualifiers for this Championship

Class 3 In Hand - Highland Pony youngstock

a) yearling

b) two year old

c) three year old

(This class may be amalgamated if insufficient entries)

Youngstock championship-1st and 2nd prizewinners from classes 3a,3b & 3c eligible

Highland Pony Society Youngstock Championship 2022

The Youngstock Champion will qualify. If already qualified, the qualification will pass to the Reserve Champion.

Class 4 In Hand - Highland mare- 4 years & over

Class 5 In Hand - Highland gelding or stallion - 4 years & over

(If there are sufficient entries this class may be divided)

Highland In Hand Championship 1st & 2nd Prizewinners classes 3-5 eligible

Ridden

Class 6 Nursery Novice Ridden – Highland 4 years and over

Walk and trot, canter in individual show optional - for newbies and novices

NPS/NEWDALE STUD M & M Confined Novice Ridden Winter Championship

To be run under National Pony Society Rules 2021/2022

Class 7 is a qualifier for this Championship

Class 7 Novice Ridden – Highland - 4 years & over

NPS/AREA 10 M&M Open Ridden Winter Championship

To be run under National Pony Society Rules 2021/2022

Class 8 is a qualifier for this championship

Class 8 Open Ridden – Highland – 4 years & over

Highland Ridden Championship – 1st & 2nd Prizewinners from classes 6-8 eligible

Class 9 Best condition - Dartmoor, Exmoor & Shetland Stallion, Mare or gelding any age

Class 10 Best condition - Fell and Dales Stallion, Mare or gelding any age

Best Condition Championship 1st & 2nd Prizewinners from classes 9 & 10 eligible

NPS/Leyhills Stud M & M in hand Championship

To be run under National Pony Society Rules 2021/2022

Classes 11 - 14 are qualifiers for this Championship

Class 11 In Hand - Dartmoor, Exmoor & Shetland Youngstock 1,2 & 3 year old Colt, Filly or Gelding

Class 12 In Hand - Fell and Dales Youngstock 1,2 & 3 year old Colt, Filly or Gelding

Class 13 In Hand - Dartmoor, Exmoor & Shetland 4 years and over Stallion, Mare or Gelding

Class 14 In Hand - Fell and Dales 4 years and over Stallion, Mare or Gelding

In hand Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland Championship 1st & 2nd Prizewinners from classes 11 & 13 are eligible

In hand Fell & Dales Championship 1st & 2nd Prizewinners from classes 12 & 14 are eligible

NPS/KILMANNAN STUD M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship

The highest placed pony of each breed in classes 3,4,5,11,12,13 & 14 are eligible

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony in the Overall In Hand Championship. The Sponsor's Rosette is also awarded to the pony receiving the qualification

Ridden

Class 15 Lead rein/first ridden – Dartmoor, Exmoor and Shetland - 4 years and over
(may be split if sufficient entries)

NPS/NEWDALE STUD M & M Confined Novice Ridden Winter Championship

To be run under National Pony Society Rules 2021/2022

Class 16 and 17 are qualifiers for this Championship

Class 16 Novice Ridden - Dartmoor, Exmoor & Shetland - 4 year and over

Class 17 Novice Ridden – Fells and Dales- 4 year and over

NPS/AREA 10 M&M Open Ridden Winter Championship

To be run under National Pony Society Rules 2021/2022

Class 18 and 19 is a qualifier for these Championships

Class 18 Open ridden - Dartmoor, Exmoor and Shetland – 4 years and over

Class 19 Open ridden – Fell and Dales – 4 years and over

Ridden Dartmoor, Exmoor and Shetland championship 1st & 2nd Prizewinners from classes 15,16 and 18 eligible

Ridden Fells & Dales championship 1st and 2nd prizewinners from class 17 and 19 eligible

NPS/STANDING HAT STUD & SHOW TEAM M&M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship 1st Prizewinners from classes 7,8,16,17,18 & 19 are eligible for this championship

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony in the NPS Affiliated Ridden section

Ring 3 Dressage 9am – start judge tbc **(All classes are open to registered pure bred M & M ponies)**

This competition is affiliated to the National Pony Society. Classes B and C are qualifiers for the **NPS SUPREME DRESSAGE CHAMPIONSHIP 2022**. Membership of the NPS is not required to qualify for the Dressage Finals but you must be a fully paid up Dressage, Full or Life member in order to compete at the final. Ponies must be ridden at the final by the qualifying rider. Qualifying cards will be awarded to the two highest placed ponies from each of the following – Dales, Fell, Highland and other M & M breeds. Junior rider qualifying cards will also be awarded.

Class A Introductory Walk/Trot Test B (will run between 9 am and 10 am)

Class B Prelim No. 14 (will run between 10 am and 11 am)

Class C Novice No. 28 (will run between 11 am and 12 noon)

Dressage Rules

1. To be judged under British Dressage Rules except where otherwise stated.
2. Snaffle bits (per British Dressage rule book) to be worn

NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds

This Show is a qualifier for the NPS Winter Championships. **Highland Classes to be run under National Pony Society Rules 2021 for Breed Shows. Fell, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor and Shetland Classes to be run under National Pony Society Rules 2021.** You do not need to be a member of The National Pony Society to compete in any class at this Show. The Rules for the NPS can be found on their website www.nationalponysociety.com. All competitors must be deemed to have read the present rules of the National Pony Society, and other relevant Native Pony Societies Rules.

In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2020/2021 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2021 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions. Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. At breed shows Silver Medals may be won by non-members. The owner of a qualified pony must become an NPS Adult Qualifying or Life member to enter the final. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

By entering this Show you agree to abide by the following conditions:

1. All persons entering the show must have Personal and Public Liability Insurance. The Highland Pony Enthusiasts Club will not be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury to any animal, person or property whilst on the showground
2. **All ponies attending the show must have current equine flu vaccination status, spot checks of passports may be made.**
3. The Judges' decision is final. Any objections must be made, in writing, within one hour of the class/incident and handed to the Secretary with a deposit of £30.
4. The Club reserve the right to amalgamate, cancel or divide classes as entries warrant.
5. The Club reserve the right to return or refuse any entry made either by post, on line or on the day.
6. Ponies will be shown in accordance to the Breed Society rules.
7. Stallions may not be led or ridden by children under the age of 12 years in accordance with NPS rules.
8. Any abusive language or behaviour towards show officials, animals or fellow competitors will result in expulsion from the showground. Excessive assistance or interference from outside the ring will not be tolerated.
9. **Any current Covid protocols will be enforced and the HPEC will not under any circumstances accept responsibility for potential effects of contracting Covid at this event**
